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**For Your Information**

1. A \$21,671,867 contract has been awarded to Chester Bross Construction Co/C.B. Equipment, Inc., of Hannibal for improvements to I-55 in Ste. Genevieve County, including resurfacing and undersealing over 40 miles of the north- and southbound lanes from the Jefferson County line to Route J/N (Exit 143), as well as the installation of guard cable from Highway 67 near Crystal City to Route E near Oak Ridge.
2. A \$2,534,726 contract was awarded to Pace Construction Company, LLC, of St. Louis for asphalt resurfacing in Bollinger, Mississippi, New Madrid, Scott and Stoddard Counties. The project in Bollinger County includes thin lift overlays on Highway 92 from Highway 51 to Highway 25 in Bollinger and Stoddard Counties.
3. The Southeast Coalition for Roadway Safety recently awarded the Perry County Sheriff Department a \$2,700 radar unit to replace a 10-year old unit and aid in speed limit enforcement in the County.
4. The Southeast Coalition for Roadway Safety also awarded the Fredericktown Police Department \$1,480 in overtime enforcement funding and three Portable Breath Testers (PBT's) to go toward DWI check points and saturation patrols to enforce Missouri's drinking and driving laws.
5. Three area schools have been recognized as winners of the 2011 Battle of the Belt Challenge. Notre Dame High School in Cape Girardeau won the southeast regional award for the highest overall seat belt use achieving 100% seat belt use. Saxony Lutheran High School of Cape Girardeau County and Valle High School were also recognized for bronze awards indicating 91 to 94% seat belt use.
